

# Random graphs and measured equivalence relations

Measured equivalence relations endowed with leafwise graph structures can be considered as "measure-theoretical skeletons" of usual topological foliations and laminations. On the other hand, they provide a natural framework for the probabilistic notion of a "random graph". After a general discussion we shall illustrate the interrelation between these two approaches by looking at the particular example of horospheric products of random trees.
